SALC contains 10 computers, a large DVD and book collection, as well as 9 televisions for watching and recording programmes in foreign languages. Interactive software programs and newspapers or magazines are available in many languages. Languages courses are offered in

coordination with the English Language Centre. Students can prepare for TOEFL & IELTS tests there. Furthermore, summer courses for foreign students take place in the ELC.
